This template describes how to write a simple abstract of the conference contribution. For all types of contributions (plenary lectures, contributed talks, minisymposia talks, posters, and industrial workshop talks), the total length of the abstract should not exceed one page.

The title is without capatalizing the fist character of each word. In case of several authors, the name of the corresponding and presenting person should be underlined. Affiliations of the authors should be described shortly, including the institution, city and country.

The main body text clearly states the purpose of the contribution and the originality of the results. The abstract should not include any key words or footnotes. The citations and references are allowed.
