PROCESSING COOKIES ON WEB PAGES

What cookies are

The website of the Institute of Geonics of the CAS uses cookies. Generally, these are small text files that your Internet browser stores on your computer. There they help identify the pages you have already visited or save your work. Cookies are necessary for the proper functionality of most websites and allow them to identify your computer when you restart your browser. They also make the website settings easier and help you sign in to your account. They make browsing the web more comfortable and faster for you.

In accordance with the legislation, in particular Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, known as "GDPR"), some cookies are considered to be personal data due to their nature.

According to the legislation, websites may store cookies on your devices without your consent only if they are strictly necessary for their operation. These are so-called technical cookies. All the other file types require your consent. Their usage is possible only from the moment of your consent. Until then, websites may not create or store them on your computer.

Different types of cookies can be stored on your computer for different time periods. Some are deleted after closing the browser window, others after closing the Internet browser. Others remain on the computer for longer, for up to 25 months, or until you delete them yourself.

Types of cookies

Websites can use three different types of cookies:

- Technical cookies are used for data transmission and electronic communication in the
 network, and only to the extent necessary for the operation of the website. They are not
 used for any other purpose and no user consent is required to use them.
- Statistical / analytical cookies (such as Google Analytics) are anonymized and are used exclusively for statistical purposes for webmasters. They make websites more accessible and user-friendly. The user's consent is required to use these cookies.
- Marketing / preferential cookies store data in order to adapt the advertisement to the specific interests of the user. This type of cookies may be used by third-party services that use the website (e. g., personalized advertising on social networks such as Facebook or Youtube). The user's consent is required to use marketing cookies.

Web presentation of the Institute of Geonics of the CAS uses only a minimum number of cookies, exclusively of a technical type. These cookies are used to store data about the used language version of the website and also to log the user into private parts of the website. Therefore, the user's consent to the processing of cookies is not explicitly required.
